In accordance with *Rule 108 Guidelines For Preservation Of Court Records In Electronic Format* I find that the 18th Judicial District Court will meet the requirements of Section II relative to preserving court records exclusively in electronic format.

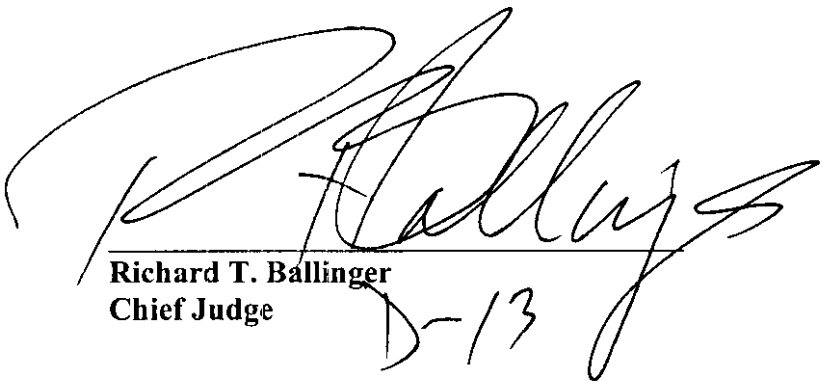
"II. Preserving Court Records Exclusively In Electronic Format: Prior to preserving court records exclusively in an electronic format, the chief judge of the judicial district must certify the following to the judicial administrator or his designee:"

The Court has considered all aspects, including future costs and technical upgrades, involved in maintaining, preserving, and retrieving records in electronic formats and is committed to preserving and maintaining access to these records

The Court has further discussed this with the Clerk of the District Court and the Court Administrator for the 18th Judicial District. It is in the best interest of the 18th Judicial District and fiscally appropriate to adapt the rule as set forth herein.

It is therefore ordered that the 18th Judicial District will no longer use microfilm in preserving the court documents and filings and will preserve all court records exclusively in electronic format from the date of this order, forward. This Administrative Order shall be retroactive to January 1st, 2005.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
