ORDER REGARDING TRAFFIC COURT DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Given the significant number of identified and projected cases of COVID-19 across Kansas and the severity of risk posed to the public when gathered in large numbers and close proximity, it is hereby ORDERED that, effective Monday, March 16, 2020:

Any TRAFFIC case currently set for:

TRIAL,  
PROBATION VIOLATION or  
DUI SENTENCING

WILL OCCUR unless prior arrangements have been made to continue the hearing.

Any TRAFFIC court for cases set for:

DISPOSITION or  
APPEARANCE ON A SUMMONS

WILL NOT OCCUR until April 6, 2020 or until further order of the court.

You will have thirty (30) days from the date that traffic court resumes to appear on your case. If the court extends this notice beyond April 6, 2020, additional notices will be posted by the court. If you have questions about your case, please call your attorney.

There will be NO MORNING OR AFTERNOON TRAFFIC WALK-IN DOCKETS until April 6, 2020, or until further order of the court.
