In consideration of the current COVID-19 outbreak and in an effort to prevent unnecessary overcrowding of the Sedgwick County Jail, Administrative Order 20-4 is hereby extended until May 31, 2020.

Any party arrested on a bench warrant issued in a domestic case for failure to appear, after being booked into jail, shall be released on their own recognizance and shall be ordered to appear in court on the first Friday following 90 days from the date of arrest, at 9:00 am in courtroom 4-1 of the Sedgwick County Courthouse. Any party that fails to appear on that date shall be subject to a new bench warrant being issued.

This Administrative Order shall be in effect until May 31, 2020, at which time it shall expire.
